# Powell Recreation District - Men's Basketball League Rules (revised 02-15-24)

Wyoming High School rules apply with these modifications and additions:

1. High School students competing interscholastically or individuals playing college varsity ball (not including redshirts), or having played this season, may not play in the league.
2. Players may only play on one team, but will be allowed to switch teams by March 16.
3. Games will consist of four, twelve (12) minute quarters, running time. **The clock will stop for time outs, injuries, and during the last two (2) minutes of the game on all dead balls.** Overtime: Five (5) minute overtime(s), running time (same clock rules as 4<sup>th</sup> quarter). One additional time out will be granted to each team.
4. Each team will be allotted four (4) time outs per game. One additional time out will be granted for each overtime period.
5. Teams without enough players will be allotted ten (10) minutes after scheduled start time before a forfeit will be called. Teams may start a game shorthanded with four (4) players.
6. Teams will be responsible for calling their own penalties during league play. Officials and scorekeepers will be provided for the season tournament. Cooperation is expected.
7. **Free throws will be shot on all shooting fouls and on the 5<sup>th</sup> team foul of each quarter**
8. Teams will be in the Bonus during the last two (2) minutes of league games.
9. A player must participate in three (3) league games to be eligible for tournament play.
10. When scheduled, each team will be responsible for providing two scorekeepers. Teams failing to do so will be fined \$5.00 for each missing scorekeeper. Failure to pay the fine prior to the next game will constitute a forfeit for each game until the fine is paid.
11. Personal fouls for individual players will not be kept during league play. Personal fouls and team fouls will be counted for the tournament.
12. Designated Team Managers will be the only team members allowed to discuss rule interpretations (not eyesight or judgment) with the officials.
13. The supervisor(s) of the league shall have complete authority on and/or off the court to take any appropriate action against a team or individual for violation of any or all rules.
14. Children must accompany an adult and will be restricted to the bleacher areas.
15. Foul language, and/or abusive or vulgar behavior will not be tolerated either on or off the floor. A person in violation of this may cause a forfeiture of the game by his team. In addition, both the violator and his team may be suspended from the league.

**Flagrant Fouls.** No player or coach shall at any time lay a hand upon, shove, strike, kick, or threaten an official, player, or spectator. Any player deliberately presenting a situation that could cause injury to another player will be automatically suspended from the league. (i.e. a player deliberately running under an opponent attempting a lay up) Supervisors and/or officials are required to eject the player immediately from further play and the player must leave the facility. After the case has been considered, the Recreation Director shall determine the penalty for such actions.

**Remember: A little sportsmanship goes a long way towards making your league better!!!**
